- •We are commanded to hate evil:
- Psa. 97:10 Let those who love the LORD hate evil, for he guards the lives of his faithful ones and delivers them from the hand of the wicked.
- Psa. 101:3 I will set before my eyes no vile thing.
 The deeds of faithless men, I hate; they will not cling to me.
- Psa. 119:104-105 I gain understanding from your precepts; therefore I hate every wrong path. Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

- Psa.119:128 and because I consider all your precepts right, I hate every wrong path.
- Psa. 119:163 I hate and abhor falsehood, but I love your law.
- Prov. 8:13 To fear the LORD is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech.
- Prov. 8:36 But whoever fails to find me (wisdom, B.D.) harms himself; all who hate me love death. Fools hate knowledge

- <u>Eccl. 3:8</u> there is . . . a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.
- Amos 5:15 Hate the evil, love the good, and establish justice in the courts...
- Micah 3:1-2 Then I said, 'Listen, you leaders of Jacob, you rulers of the house of Israel. Should you not know justice, you who hate good and love evil?'
- Rev. 2:6 But you have this in your favor: you hate the practices of the Nicolaitans which I also hate.

- Things God hates:
- <u>Deut. 16:22</u> Neither will you set up any image which the LORD your God hates.
- Mal. 2:16 'I hate divorce,' says the LORD God of Israel . . .
- Prov. 6:16 These six things the LORD hates: yes, even seven are an abomination to Him . . .
- Isa. 61:8 For I, the LORD, love justice; I hate robbery and iniquity. . .

- Jer. 44:3-4 Because of the evil they have done, they provoked me to anger by burning incense and by worshiping other gods that neither they nor you nor your fathers ever knew. Again and again I sent my servants, the prophets, who said, 'Do not do this detestable thing that I hate!'
- Zech. 8:17 'Do not plot evil against your neighbor, and do not love to swear falsely. I hate all this,' declares the LORD.

- Matt. 5: 43 48
- Lev. 19:1 Do not hate your brother in your heart . . .
- In. 2:9 & 11 Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates his brother is still in the darkness (Cosmic Compound). Vs 11 Whoever hates his brother is in the darkness and walks around in the darkness; he does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded him.

 In. 4:20-21 - If anyone says, 'I love God,' yet hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. And He has given us this command: 'Whoever loves God must also love his brother.'

- Hatred BY of Believers before Jesus Christ returns -
- •Matt. 24:10-11 At that time, many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people.

- Believers who stand for God's Word can expect to be hated by others:
- Luke 6:22 You are blessed when men hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man.
- John 15:17-19 This is my command: Love each other. If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you.
